- Assumption University (faculty and students)
- Centre for Executive and Professional Education
- Community College Faculty (St. Clair, Lambton)
- Daimler Chrysler Automotive Research Centre (faculty and staff)
- High School Students
- Iona College (faculty and students)
- Joint Ph.D. program in Education students
- Nursing Program Preceptors
- School of Social Work Field Instructors
- St. Clair and Lambton College (faculty only)
- U. of W. Giving Program (Chancellor's Circle, Governor's Club, President's Council)
- Visiting Scholars and Professors (with proof of visiting status)
