Application / Scope of Policy

We have restricted wireless access and patrons need an active UWinID or a member institution in Eduroam (<https://www.eduroam.org/>).

Connecting to Wi-Fi; instructions for using Eduroam:

Eduroam is a network used by many universities, and your UWindsor sign in will work at any campus that uses eduroam.

1. Open Wi-Fi settings on your device and select the “eduroam” network
2. Depending on your device you will be prompted for different settings. Here is the list of all possibilities:
Fill in any you see. (Most computers will only ask for Username and Password)
 - EAP method: PEAP
 - Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPV2
 - CA certificate: Use System Certificates (or leave blank if this is not an option) or Do not validate
 - Identity (username): Your full UWindsor email (example@uwindsor.ca)
 - **OR:** Anonymous identity: Your full UWindsor email (example@uwindsor.ca)
 - Password: Your UWinID password
3. If prompted to trust a certificate after signing in (mainly iPhone) click trust.
